Briefly describe what happened

Please remove/disable https://aggropvp.com and https://skynetslegion.com because they are being used as part of a coordinated harassment and impersonation campaign to damage my business and intimidate me and my family. The operator used fake profiles to contact me and then directed traffic to these domains. The sites published targeted abuse, directly targeted my fiance, and displayed private images including intimate images of me and images of my children (minors). This is non-consensual distribution of private material and creates immediate safety risk.

After complaints, aggropvp.com replaced the abusive content with a DMCA-looking "content removal" notice with a case number and "permanently removed" status. This is misleading and appears to be a fraudulent use of the DMCA process to conceal what was hosted while continuing the same targeting. skynetslegion.com is a deceptive "comparison" site that impersonates an impartial review to steer users to a competitor and spread false
